<p>A. <b>Federal Performance Measure 1, 2, 3 Targets</b> – Alicia Hunter and Ashley Bryers, WAMPO</p> <p><i>FHWA and FTA jointly issued a Planning Rule that establishes various performance measures to assess roadway safety (PM1), pavement and bridge condition (PM2), system performance and freight movement (PM3), transit asset management (TAM), and transit safety. State DOTs and MPOs are required to set targets for the various federal performance measures. WAMPO has chosen to support and accept KDOT's 2023 PM1 targets and 2024 and 2026 PM2 and PM3 targets for the WAMPO region.</i></p>

Using KDOT data, WAMPO staff have developed a 2021 Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) Report to illustrate traffic volumes on six (6) major corridors within the WAMPO region.</i>	
D. <b>EV Planning Process</b> – Dora Gallo, WAMPO <i>WAMPO is in the process of developing an Electric Vehicle Plan, in support of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) 2050 and the Charge Up Kansas NEVI Plan.
