A. <b><u>2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Amendment 2</u></b> – Chad Parasa and Ashley Bryers, WAMPO <i>A version of Amendment 2 to the WAMPO Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) was reviewed by the TAC in April, but was not taken before the TPB for their approval because additional changes to the UPWP needed to be added to the amendment. The TAC is asked to make a recommendation on revised, proposed Amendment 2 to the 2023 UPWP to consolidate travel line items, adjust all staff line items to reflect actual hours worked, adjust the budget to accommodate anticipated expenditures based on planned work, add \$110,000 for "Consulting Services: Accounting Services" to the budget, and add the development of bicycle/pedestrian-facility maps for public use using the latest technology, such as mobile apps. The public comment period is 5/17/2023 through 6/1/2023. WAMPO staff will report on any public comments received by the meeting.</i>
