The intent of the 5310 Enhanced Mobility of Seniors & Individuals with Disabilities program is to improve mobility for seniors and people with disabilities by providing financial support, through programs planned, designed, and carried out to meet the transportation needs of these populations. The Wichita Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (WAMPO) has now opened the application period for 5310 program funding. The deadline for project application submission is February 28, 2023. All submitted projects will be screened based on the goals and objectives found in the local Coordinated Public Transit-Human Services Plan.
